Dr. Fondriest maintains a full-time private practice in Lake Forest, with a focus on comprehensive restorative dentistry. He has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals and lectures throughout the country to dental and laboratory associations and study groups on the fundamental principles of aesthetics and restorative dentistry. He is a curriculum author and Lead faculty for the Esthetics Continuum at the Pankey Institute and currently serves on their Board of Advisors. He gives over the shoulder hands-on cosmetics classes at the Scottsdale Center with Frank Spear and Bob Winter. He is an Advisor to Dentistry Today and has been included in their list of the top 100 educators in dentistry for many years. His memberships include: ADA, Academy of Fix Prosthodontics, Academy of Osseointegration, and the Academy of Pankey Scholars. In his free time, he enjoys photography, good food, wine, and adventure trips.

About the Course: High quality cosmetic dentistry requires collaboration with many partners. When the restorative dentist enlists the help of his/her laboratory technician, dental specialists and client patient, the restorative outcome is improved. Working with partners requires good communication techniques to keep all the players updated and engaged. This presentation will introduce many techniques that improve your ability to document and communicate clinical conditions, how to solicit better partner feedback, how to make the most appropriate treatment decision for your patient, and how to convert your plan into a satisfactory outcome.

- Photographic cosmetic evaluation
- Co-creating the treatment plan with help from your laboratory, specialists, and patient
- How the restorative dentist can best quarterback an interdisciplinary case

- Treatment sequencing to fit you and your patient's needs
- Why quality is easier to achieve with a good laboratory partnership
- What the better laboratories require from their dentist colleagues
- How the laboratory communication requirements are changing with the newer restorative materials

Gary F. Alder, D.D.S.

Dr. Alder graduated from Northwestern University Dental School in 1974. He completed a General Practice Residency at Rush University in Chicago in 1975. He is attending staff at Rush and is Director of the Rush GPR for the past 30 years, as well as private group practice. He has a long interest in head and neck pain, orthodontics, reconstruction of the head and neck cancer patient, obstructive sleep apnea, dental implants, management of the medically compromised patient, CAD/CAM restorative and, most recently, adult nutrition. He has served in several capacities in organized dentistry ranging from officer and president of the Westside Branch of CDS, Director of CDS and currently serves as Trustee of ISDS. He is on committees of Government Affairs, Continuing Education and Membership.

About the Course: This presentation will take you from start to finish in assessing and treating the medically compromised patient. What to look for and which diagnostic aids to utilize will be covered. Dr. Alder will address the “red flags” that the dental provider should look for and how they may be detected. Specific dental problems and treatments that will be discussed include: models, orthodontics, aesthetics, periodontics, implants, sleep apnea, and head and neck pain issues. There will also be discussion of the future role of dental care as it interacts with medicine and overall health.

Goal of the Course: Attendees will develop an increased awareness of the role dentistry has in overall health, as well as how some medical conditions must play a key role in determining effective treatment planning.
