## ISDS Capital Conference 2011

Five members of the Fox River Valley Dental Society and the FRVDS Executive Director attended the ISDS Capital Conference at the Crown Plaza in Springfield April 6 and 7. This year's theme was "Dentistry; One Team, One Dream."

Conference topics included updates on the ADA Annual Session, the CDS Midwinter Meeting, and the ISDS Finances. However, legislation affecting dentistry was the main focus of the conference. Attendees were briefed on pending legislation and what each one may do for the dental profession. After the briefing, a bus transported the attendees to the State Capitol to meet with their State Representatives and Senators to discuss the dental society's position on these issues. The legislators were then invited to attend a pre-dinner gathering with conference participants.

Those who attended found it tremendously valuable. Not only are the representatives and senators better informed about healthcare and dentistry, our members are building relationships with these decision makers and gaining a voice to advocate the future of dentistry.

Fox River Valley members drove to Springfield one day early in order to attend the evening meeting of the Downstate Caucus. This group is a conglomerate of all dental societies that are located outside of the Chicago Dental Society and provides for equal representation for smaller dental societies within the state of Illinois.
