**Goal of the Seminar:** This presentation is intended to provide a clear concept of the management of complex cases through the integration of several dental disciplines.

**About the Seminar:** In complex cases, all the fields of dentistry have to work together. This presentation describes which examinations and documentation are necessary to come to a diagnosis and develop a treatment plan. All the major topics will be addressed and illustrated within complex cases:

- How to deal with the occlusion
- How to manage wear on teeth
- When to extract for endodontic reasons and place an implant
- When to extract for periodontal reasons and place an implant
- What is known about implants
- Eliminating problems with implants, such as periimplantitis

**Continuing Education Credits:** Five hours of continuing education will be issued.

He is an instructor and conference speaker on the topics of endodontology, periodontology, implantology, and fixed prosthodontics and occlusion. He has served as President of the German Association of Endodontics and is an active board member of the European Dental Association and president-elect of the Kempten Study Group.
