

Constitution for DENT-IL-PAC, the Political Action Committee of the Illinois State Dental Society

****Proposed 5-13-26****

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation, organized as a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Illinois, is DENT-IL-PAC.

ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this corporation shall be to promote and further the interests of the public and of the profession of dentistry in matters of legislation and administrative regulations; to develop among the public and the profession an awareness of political issues which relate to dental public health and welfare; and to collect and disseminate funds for the purpose of carrying out these objectives, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

ARTICLE III - POWERS

The board of directors of the corporation shall have the power to direct, manage and control the business, property, and funds of the corporation and to direct its activities so that its objectives can be achieved.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE V - AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by two-thirds affirmative vote of the corporation's board of directors present at any regular Board of Directors' meeting, or at any special meeting provided that the proposed amendment shall have been presented in writing at any meeting at least ten (10) days prior to such action.
